Mowgli Street Food raises over £50,000!

We are incredibly privileged to work with some amazing companies as they support Nottingham's hospitals to recognise the care their loved ones have received.

The Nottingham branch of renowned restaurant Mowgli Street Food has partnered with Nottingham Hospitals Charity since August 2018 and, in February 2022, their fundraising passed the £50,000 milestone!

Mowgli has raised funds by adding a discretionary £1 donation to each customer's bill, and by the team taking on a range of fundraising activities. The money raised has supported our Big Appeal, funding vital equipment to enhance patient care and help paediatric neurosurgeons treat children with brain tumours. To mark reaching £50,000, five members of the Mowgli team walked a total of 50,000 steps from the restaurant on Stoney Street to City Hospital and back.

Fran, one of the team who braved the stormy weather, said: "We all had a lot of fun celebrating this milestone, despite the rainy weather. And while

it was planned that we walk 10,000 steps each, 50,000 between the five of us, it actually turned out that we walked 10 kilometres each, which was over 65,000 steps!"

In 2020, the team at Mowgli joined an incubator push from QMC to Nottingham City Centre, raising money for the Baby MRI Appeal, enabling Nottingham Hospitals to provide a special incubator to help the smallest of patients. This year they are planning a static bike challenge and other fundraising events to support our new Hayward House Appeal.



We are so grateful to be partnered with Mowgli, an organisation passionate about giving back to their community and helping to enhance patient care, right here in Nottinghamshire.

Nottingham Children's Hospital Big Appeal -Over £3 million

raised to date

In November 2016 we launched our Big Appeal in aid of Nottingham Children's Hospital. Our aim was to raise money for enhanced facilities, special medical equipment and a child-focused environment for young patients and their families at Nottingham Children's Hospital, which is based at the Queen's Medical Centre. Thanks to the generosity of our donors, the appeal has raised over £3million to date, which has enabled us to fund life-changing equipment and facilities for children and their families.

Funds from the Big Appeal have refurbished parent and family accommodation, providing a home from home for families whose children are being treated at the hospital, and part funded an intraoperative MRI machine, which has revolutionised the treatment of children with brain tumours.

Andrea Gregorich stayed in the newly refurbished accommodation while her nine-month-old daughter Ella-Grace was being treated at Nottingham Children's Hospital.

"Having these rooms and me being able to be here so much makes such a huge difference. It means I am able to be here 24 hours a day, seven days a week, to look after Ella-Grace. I would simply not be able to afford to travel back and forth to Grantham every day."





New Hayward House Appeal - Help our Care Blossom

On March 30th we launched our new Hayward House Appeal. We were joined by the Lord Mayor of Nottingham, who planted a tree in the gardens, and children from Seely Primary School who helped set up wireless bird boxes so that patients can follow the progress of nesting birds and their eggs.

Hayward House is a specialist palliative care centre at the City Hospital in Nottingham. It provides a unique homefrom-home environment where patients with advanced, progressive and terminal illnesses, including those at the end of their life, can be cared for by a specialist team of doctors, nurses and therapists.

Nottingham Hospitals Charity's Appeal aims to raise £1.5 million to enhance the care environment at Hayward House and continue to provide the very best care for patients and their families. We want to enhance the garden area to make it a beautiful, tranquil space for patients and their loved ones, transform the busy and functional entrance into a calm and welcoming reception and waiting area, and expand the centre's current study facilities, allowing further research into treatment options. This is in addition to continuing to provide the extra nursing posts, complementary therapy, counselling and bereavement support that makes such a big difference to patients and their families on a daily basis.
