Thanks to your support, we're halfway to our fundraising target for a new intraoperative MRI machine at Nottingham Children's Hospital.



The Big i-MRI Appeal was launched in March 2018, and thanks to our fundraisers and donors after six months we have raised £600.000 of the £1.2m target for the new iMRI suite

The new machine will be used during children's brain surgery, to help surgeons get a clearer picture of the size and location of their patients' tumours, meaning they are more likely to be able to remove all of the tumour first time.

One year old Oliver Swift, from



Arnold, Nottingham, was diagnosed with a brain tumour at just five months old. Oliver underwent surgery, and is now undergoing chemotherapy to further shrink his tumour.

Oliver's mum Charlene said: "Oliver us a very jolly little boy and the doctors are amazed at the recovery he has made. I am very supportive of the i-MRI Appeal and know it could help children like Oliver in the future."
