Nottingham Children's Hospital - based within Queen's Medical Centre - cares for more than 60,000 young people every year. Children from across the region are treated for everything from cancer and leukaemia to kidney disease, organ transplantation, life-long acute respiratory problems and broken bones. This includes around 1,200 premature and newborn babies treated each year in the Neonatal Units at the Children's Hospital.

DIAGNOSING BRAIN TUMOURS AND OTHER CONDITIONS QUICKLY AND ACCURATELY

We want to provide the very best x-ray and scanning facilities for our young patients, in the most comfortable environment possible, to assist in diagnosis and treatment, reduce waiting times and hospital stays, and ultimately save lives. As part of this we want to help fund a new state-of-the-art intra-operative MRI (iMRI) scanner, which will benefit children suffering from brain tumours. The team at Nottingham Children's Hospital performs more than 500 brain tumour operations each year, and this new machine will help achieve the best possible outcomes for patients by guiding surgeons during extremely delicate operations, which can be difficult to perform with the naked eye alone. This means young patients are more likely to receive successful surgery, and less likely to need multiple operations. The machine will also aid vital research into brain tumours.

It is our aim to raise £2.5 million to provide a range of diagnostic, imaging and operating equipment for the Children's Hospital.

LOOKING AFTER PARENTS AND FAMILIES

Parents of children and babies in hospital can be faced with having to travel long distances each day often for weeks and months at a time. Families have to use hotel rooms or sleep on a chair at their child's bedside - causing exhaustion and increasing anxiety and stress. It is our aim to raise money to really enhance parent and family accommodation at Nottingham Children's Hospital. We want to provide comfortable places to stay that are close to their child, enabling more support, time and energy to focus on being together.

We need to raise around £1.5 million to enhance parent and family accommodation at Nottingham Children's Hospital.



TRANSFORMING FACILITIES

Thanks to our amazing supporters, we have been able to contribute £1.1m to help refurbish and redevelop the children's cancer and neurosciences wards - funding colourful wall art, state-of-the-art air filtration and improved communal areas like play spaces and relatives' rooms. It is our aim to **raise an additional £100,000 a year** to enable us to continue to support important improvements to the environment of Nottingham Children's Hospital.

SUPPORTING YOUNG PEOPLE AND CELEBRATING 20 YEARS OF OUR YOUTH SERVICE



This is a special year for the Children's Hospital's Youth Service who are celebrating 20 years of helping young people with chronic illness or disability have as much of a normal life as possible. You can help us fund their youth club and residential trips away.

Funds raised also support the Children's Hospital's Play and Development Service, providing essential support to young patients and their families - taking their mind off painful procedures and difficult experiences and helping them to communicate their anxieties and fears. PROVIDING COMPLEMENTARY THERAPY

Nottingham Children's Hospital is one of the only children's hospitals in the country to offer complementary therapy treatments to all its children and young people. Services like aromatherapy, relaxation techniques and massage offer pain relief, reduce anxiety and help to improve the quality of life for patients. We need to **raise an additional £50,000** to be able to continue providing this unique service for patients.
