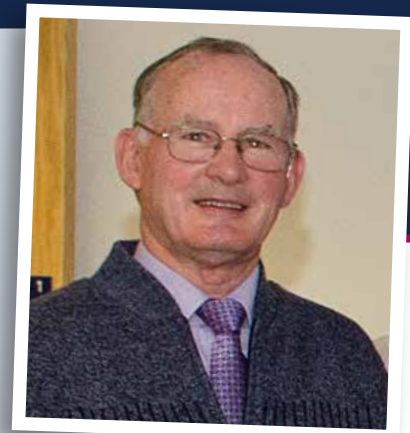


David's story

David Bassett is one of the survivors of prostate cancer. He was diagnosed with the disease at the age of 57 and was treated at the City Hospital in Nottingham.

"It was a real shock to be diagnosed with prostate cancer. It was a very frightening time for me and my family. The treatment I received from the whole team at the City Hospital was excellent, they took great care of me.

"Since then I have realised how many people it affects, as I know several people who have also suffered with the disease. It affects young people as well, not just older people, so we need to be very aware of it.
